Hazard: Ratio of adults to children Risk - injury		Appropriate ratio of adults to scouts according to age and scouting rules; to be adhered to.	
Hazard - unacceptable behaviour Risk- injury		Leader to discuss appropriate behaviour and expectations prior to leaving or if meeting at fire station - on arrival.	
Hazard - unauthorised use of Equipment Risk - injury/death		Equipment only to be touched under the supervision of fire officers. Leaders and adults to ensure that safety rules are followed.	
Hazard -Numbers of scouts - pushing/shoving Risk - injury		Leaders to ensure that young persons wait their turn sensibly. Split the group into smaller groups if necessary. Number of young scouts previously agreed with fire station	
Hazard - Unexpected call out Risk - injury/death		Leader to have discussed with fire officers at the start re what to do and where to stand should this situation arise Visit to be aborted if required	
Hazard - Lost scouts Risk - injury/death		Head count on arrival and before leaving the fire station.
